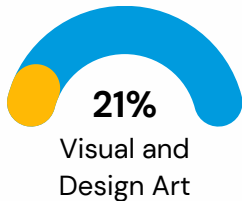
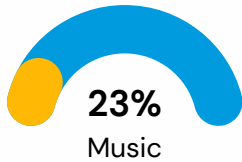
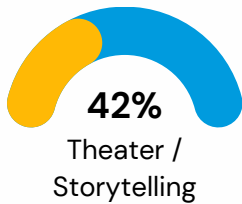




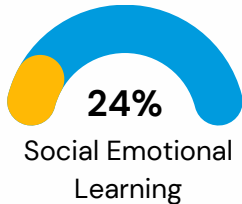
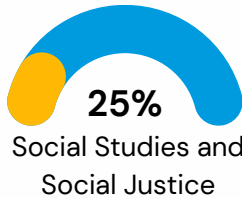
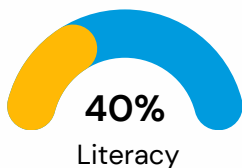
Arts for Learning Virginia Impact Report FY 2023–2024

Connecting

Arts for Learning Virginia served **38,425** students and family members, **2,241** educators, and **71** teaching artists in Virginia, while also providing access to on-demand virtual arts experiences at home to more than **26,000** students and their families.

Impacting

Arts for Learning Virginia delivered **88%** of its services in urban community settings where students and families participated in programming with our teaching artists. **86%** of programming was presented as in- and after-school performances, workshops, and residencies while **14%** of our programming supported professional development in arts integration for educators and teaching artists.

Partnering

Arts for Learning partnered with **89** public schools. Of those, **60%** were designated as Title 1 schools that serve large numbers of low-income students. Arts for Learning also partnered with **four** postsecondary institutions; **five** independent schools; and **89** library branches, parks and recreation sites, and community venues that provide programming for at-risk youth, seniors, and students with autism.

Transforming

Arts for Learning provided **612** culturally rich arts experiences for a total of **1,640** programming hours to students, families, educators, and teaching artists, touching individuals in profound ways.
