Student/Teacher Actions


- 1. Ask students about a time when they felt someone was being good to them.
- 2. Play Tales of Goodness.
- 3. Ask students to share with a partner which of the stories was their favorite and why.
- 4. Allow students to share responses in a whole group discussion.

 Ask students to go home and talk to their parents about three things that they can do at home and in school that are good.
