

## **Student/Teacher Actions**

- 1. To check for prior knowledge, ask students if they have ever heard of Martha Ann Fields.
- 2. Play Come Freedom, Come.
- 3. Ask students to answer the following question in a written reflection:

How did Martha Ann Field's choice to leave the plantation with her children affect their futures? What do you think would have happened had she not decided to leave?

# **Extensions and Connections**

 Have students do research on Martha Ann Field's children to find out more about what they did with their lives after they were freed from slavery.
