

**Student/Parent Actions**

1. Ask your child if they know the colors of the rainbow.
2. Play Count + Color Magic
3. Help your child draw a picture of a house using a variety of shapes including circles, squares, and triangles.
4. Ask your child to pick out five colors to use to decorate their house.
5. Ask your child to name and count the five crayons, markers, or colored pencils they selected.
6. Have your child color in their house.

**Extensions and Connections**

- Ask your child to collect smaller household items. This could be coins, pens, utensils, books, stuffed animals, etc. Have them line up and count all the items they found.
- Go for a walk with your child and ask them to point out objects and identify what color they are.

- Bring your child outside and ask them to draw shapes with sidewalk chalk.
- Visit the Virginia Zoo.
- Visit the Chrysler Museum of Art.
